

FUSION FC PLAYER AGREEMENT

PLAYER COMMITMENTS

1. Dedication to Fusion FC ideals and mission.
2. Strict adherence to the coach's instructions.
3. Attendance at all games, with arrival time to be determined by the coach.
4. Maintaining the highest standard of conduct and good sportsmanship.
5. Maintaining team and Club dress standards.
6. Maintaining high academic standards.
7. Attendance at all training sessions:
 - (a) Attendance at practice is mandatory. The coach or manager must be advised at the earliest possible time of any exceptional circumstances causing player's absence.
 - (b) All practices will be organized and run by coaching staff.
 - (c) Players must be on time and dressed in appropriate practice attire which includes soccer boots, correct socks, soccer appropriate jersey and shin guards and takes weather conditions into account.
 - (d) Players **MUST** bring their own water (32 oz recommended) to practice.
 - (e) Players **MUST** bring a **USABLE** soccer ball to practice.
 - (f) Players should not arrive at practice site more than 15 minutes prior to scheduled starting time.
 - (g) Players arriving early will use the time to warm up.
 - (h) Players will not interfere with other team practices being conducted at the same site.
 - (i) Players are expected to assist in gathering practice materials at the conclusion of each practice.
 - (j) Players **MUST** be at site, ready to begin on time.
 - (k) Coach or Manager will remain at practice site until all players have left or parents contacted.
8. School soccer (games and practices) takes precedence over the Club soccer games and practices. School sports other than soccer do not take precedence over Club games or practices.
9. Male club players U12 and older, may not participate in recreational soccer. Female club players U14 and older, may not participate in recreational soccer.
10. Player attendance at all games is mandatory except in highly unusual circumstances. Absences may result in reduced playing time in the team's next game(s) or other appropriate corrective action decided upon by the coach.
11. Players wear only the approved and issued Club uniform during match play and are expected to take pride in their appearance when representing the Club. Shin guards are mandatory and shirts must be tucked in.
12. Mandatory attendance at club Tryouts for following season to be held the week immediately following the girls D1 State Finals which is usually played the last weekend in May.

CONDUCT

PARENT/PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Players:

1. Players will refrain from using profanity during games or practices.
2. Players will refrain from using disparaging dialogue with referees, teammates, coaches, opponents, or spectators.

3. Players will not, under any circumstances, participate in physical violence or threats thereof during games or practice.
4. Players will treat team mates, opponents, coaches, parents with respect and will refrain from any form of conduct including dialogue which is deemed negative and discouraging.
5. Property damage during road trips will result in suspension from the team and full restitution to the property owner by player and/or parents.
6. Players will obey the laws of the game.
7. Players will make every attempt to notify the coach prior to missing a practice in order to receive an excused absence.
8. At Fusion FC we expect our players to take the lead and show responsibility. The player, not his or her parents, should bring concerns such as playing time or the position a child plays to the coach. Some younger players may feel uncomfortable approaching the coach but still should be encouraged to do so
9. If a player decides to quit during the season they will still be responsible for the remainder of the season monthly fees and budgeted team fees.

Parents:

1. Parents agree to support the Club by encouraging players to abide by the Player Code of Conduct.
2. Parents will not verbally abuse players, coaches, referees, opponents or spectators.
3. Parents will agree to pay for property damage caused directly, or indirectly, as a result of actions of their child.
4. Parents will support the coach and will refrain from criticism during games and practices.
5. Parents will discuss constructive concerns regarding coach, players, or Club policy first with the team manager and coach, and then, if needed, with the Director of Coaching.
6. Parents will attend mandatory pre-season team meeting
7. Parents understand that coaches, managers, and directors are dedicated to quality soccer and will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with Club policies and objectives.
